

Cambodia and Vietnam

We visited KIDS EARTH HOME in Cambodia and Vietnam to hold art workshops from March 23rd to the 29th, Local children who joined the workshop were truly delighted with donated colored pencils. Those children shed tears when we shared with them the stories of how the earthquake and tsunami have affected people's lives in Japan, and then they drew pictures of the tsunami, people who are crying and also people who have lost their lives. It was emotionally stunning to see those children's sincerity and sensitivity as they express it within their pictures.



Tohoku Support Report

Even though the scars that tsunami have left are still clearly and deeply remaining as people are still living in the temporary housing and no constructions have started in washed away areas, less and less reports about current situation of the tsunami affected areas and its people are coming in as time passes by.

After the earthquake happened, tons of donations and relief goods have arrived from all over the world. However the school and temporary housing are filling up with those aids, this local person said "We may be ready to reconstruct our lives materialistically, but not emotionally and spiritually." In order to bring hopes to continue their lives, mental support must be provided to people who have lost their home and/or loved ones.
